


Ten Digit Dialing

On January 1st, 2010, The state of Oregon will start to require **10 digit dialing on all outgoing calls**. This is due to the addition of the new 458 area code in Oregon that will be sharing the same region as the 541 area code.

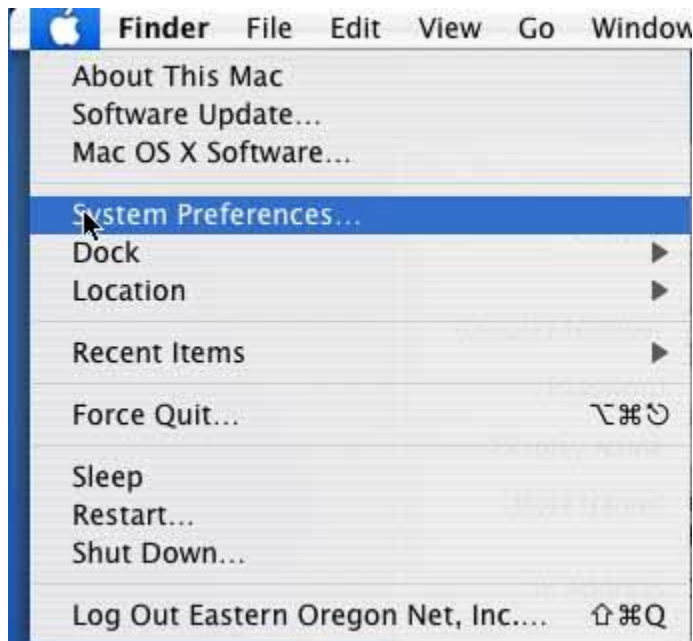
In order to prepare for this change, it is **vital** that all EONI dialup customers in this area check to make sure they are **NOW** dialing the 10 digit number because as on January 1st, 2010, 7 digit dialing will no longer work, and will return an error upon attempting to connect.

Changing the Area Code using Macintosh OS X

First we need to locate your Apple menu,  located on the upper left corner of your screen.

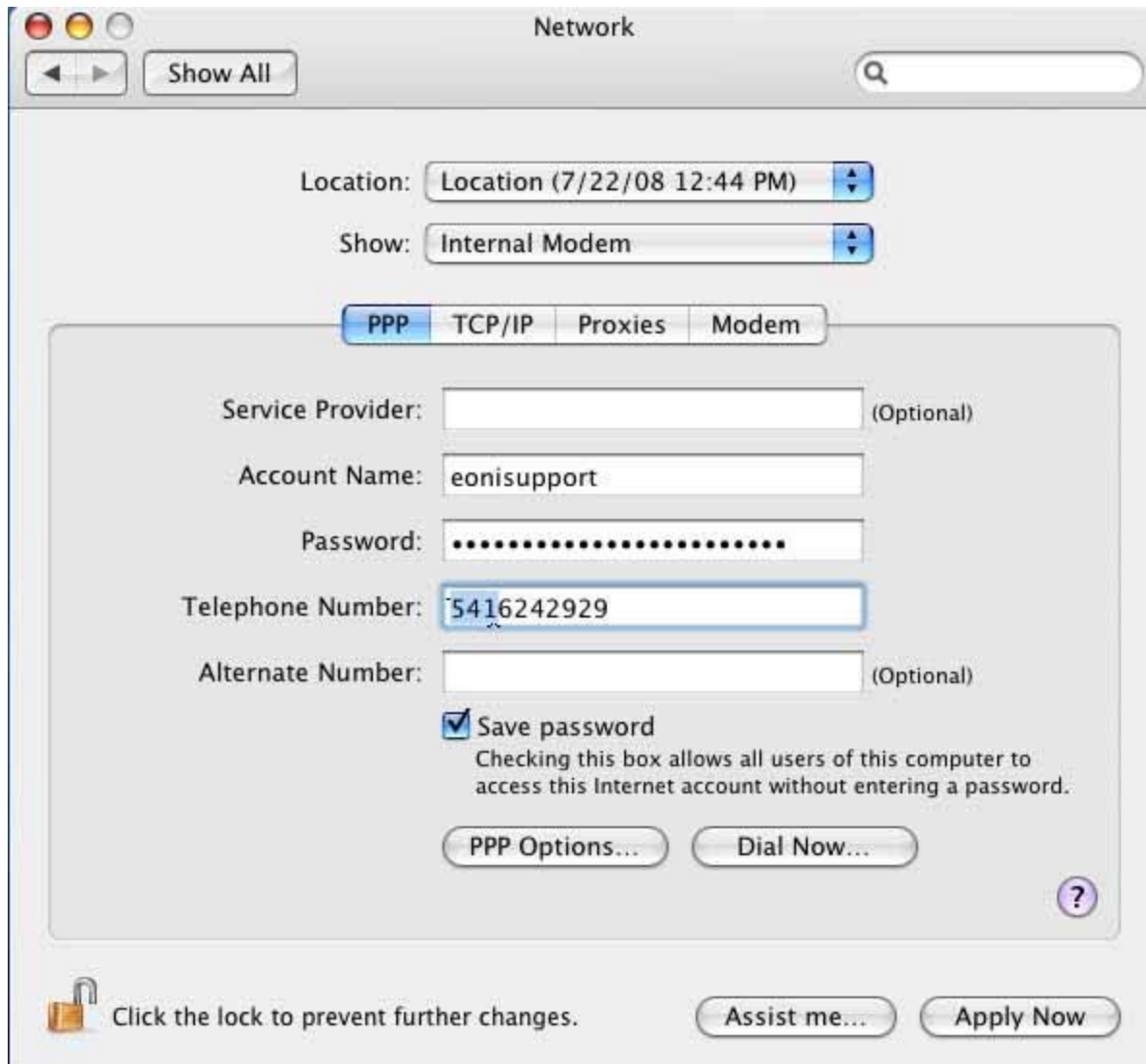
Next we click on "System Preferences".



While in the System Preferences window, we click on "Network".



While in the Network window, be sure that "show" is set to "Internal Modem", then go down to the telephone number and add the appropriate area code prefix as illustrated below:



Click on "Apply Now" to save your changes, and that's it!

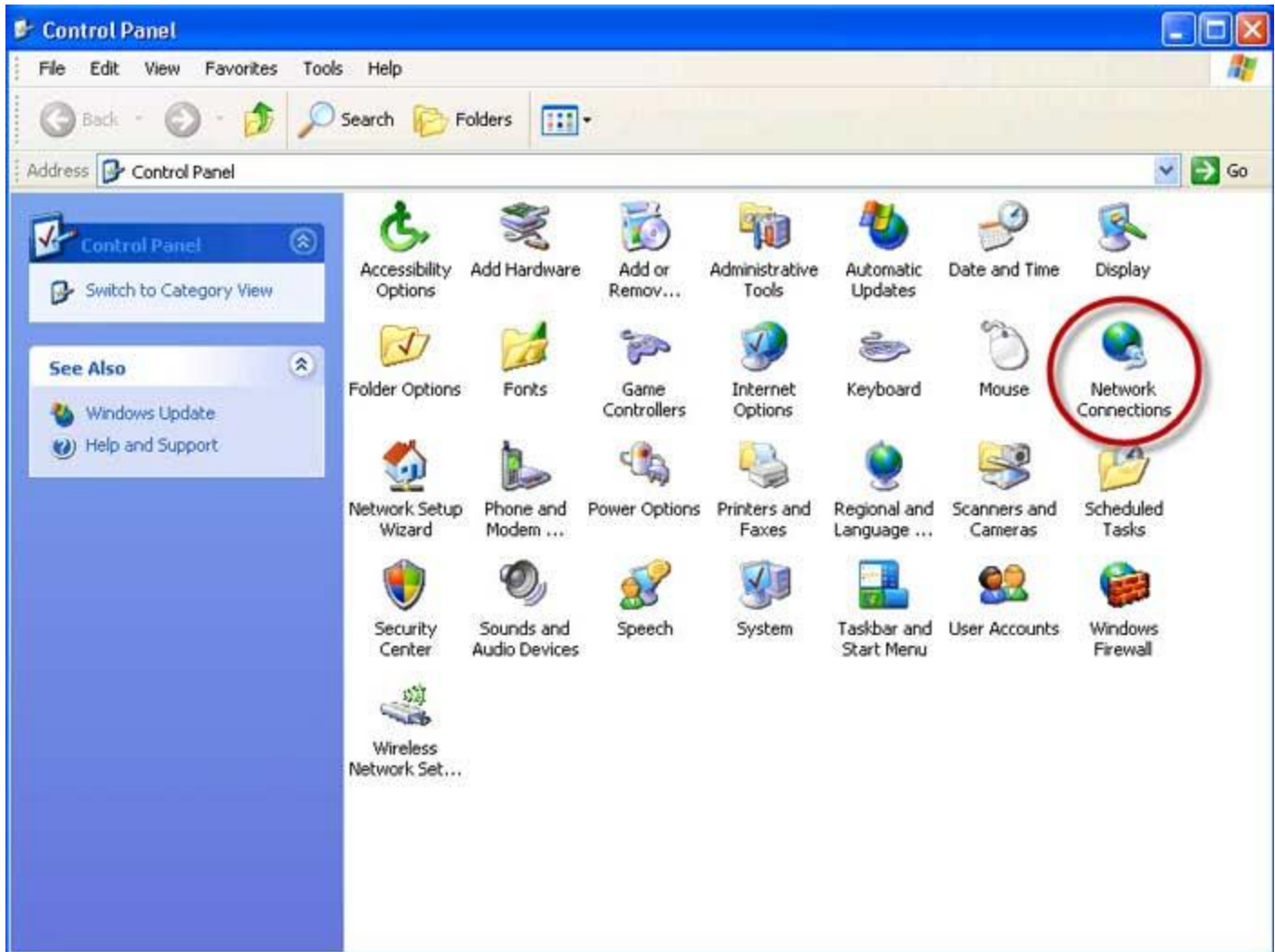
Changing the Area Code in Windows XP

First, find your Start button,  usually located on the bottom left corner of your screen.

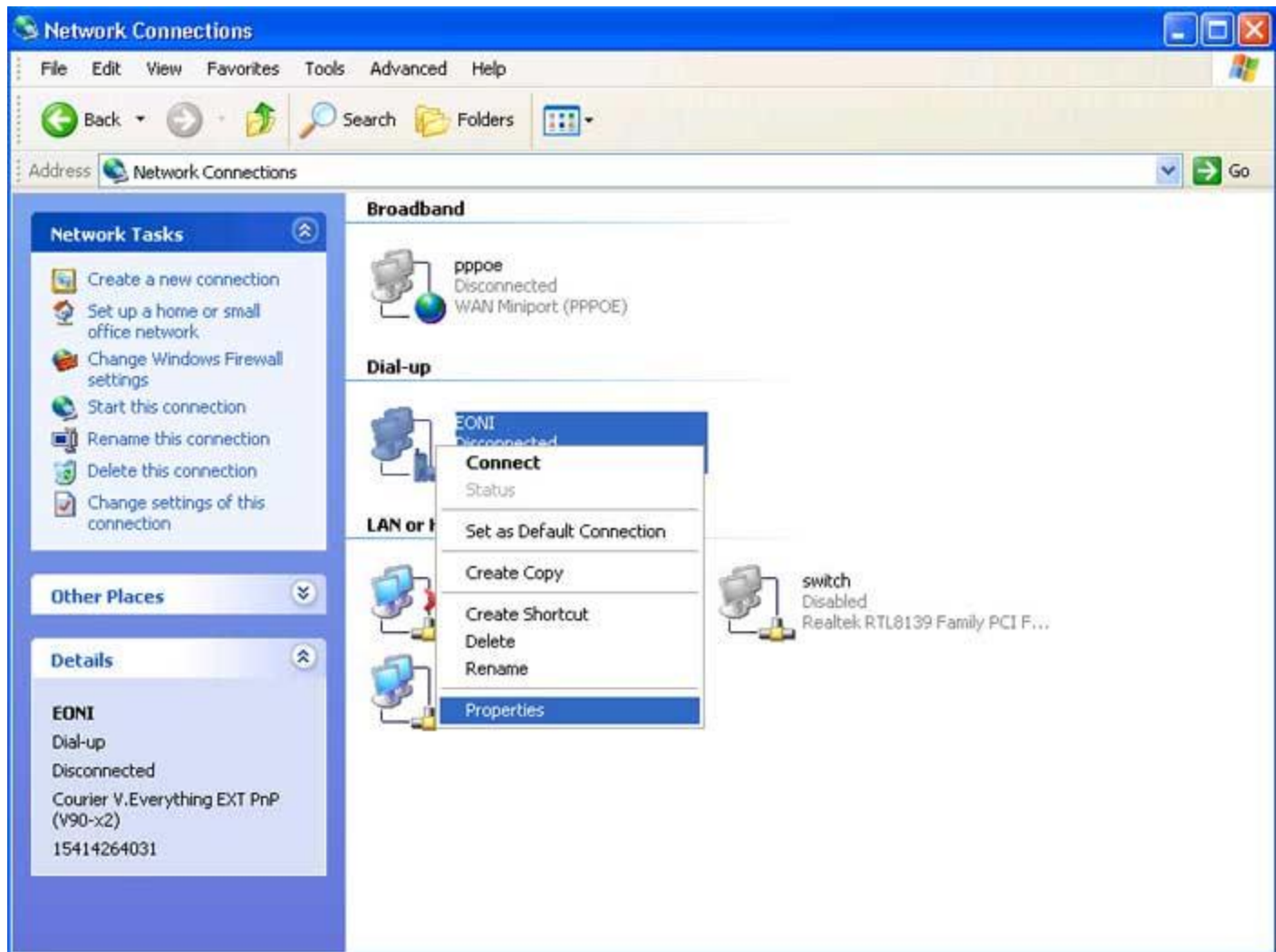
Next, we need to find and open the Control Panel, illustrated below:



Once inside the Control Panel, we need to locate and double click on "Network Connections".



Inside of Network Connections, we need to locate your EONI Dialup Connection, right click on it, and then click on "properties".




Once we've opened up EONI properties, you should find yourself on the General tab. Simply add the area code in front of the phone number as shown below:

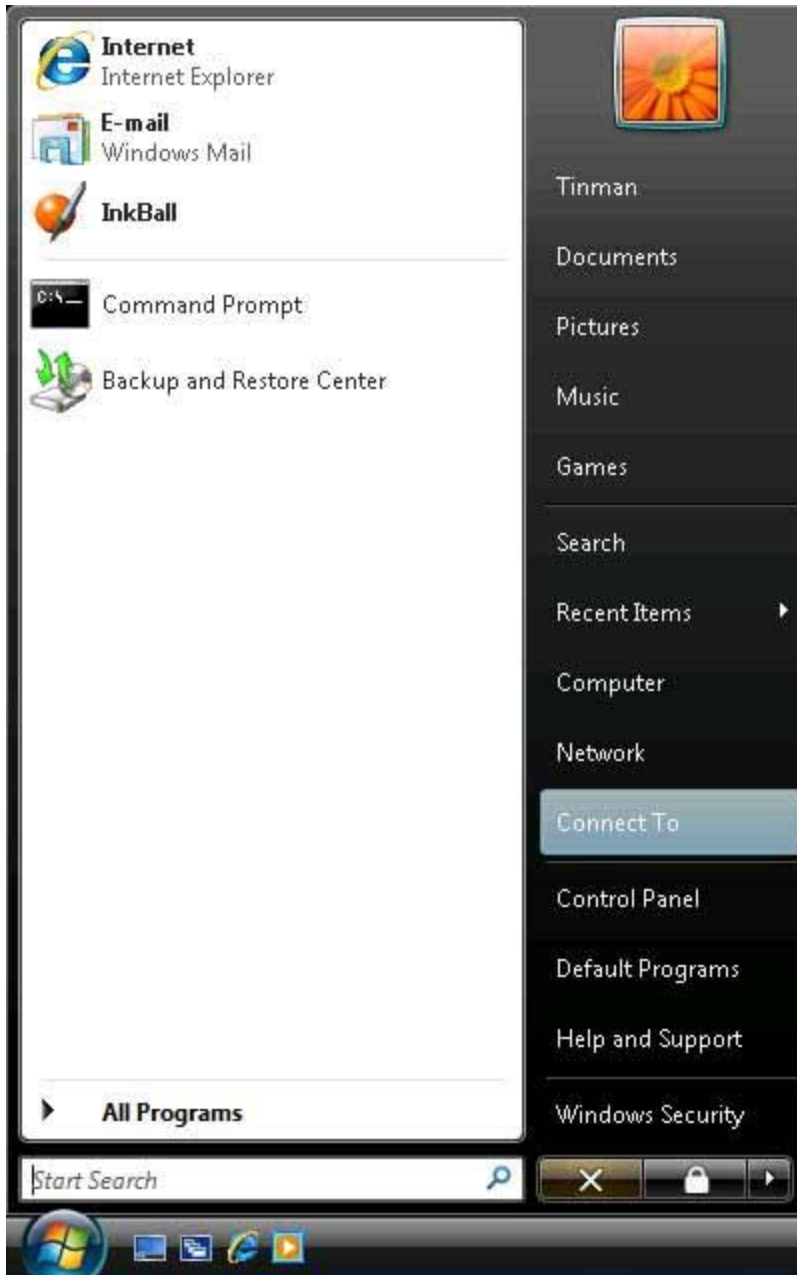


Click on "ok" on the bottom and you are done!

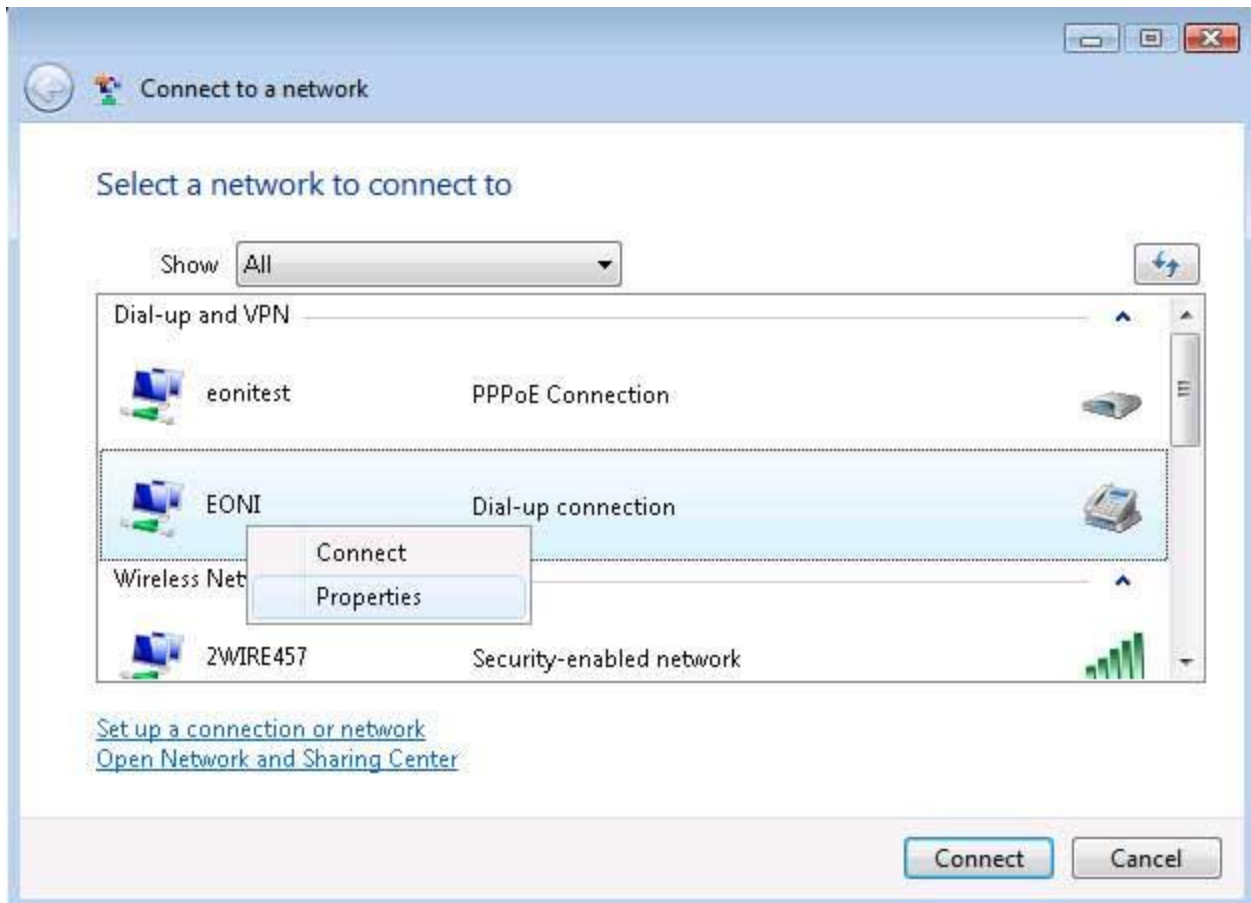
Changing the Area Code in Windows Vista (should also apply to Windows 7 and later)

First, find your Start button,  usually located on the bottom left corner of your screen.

Next, we locate and open up "Connect To":



In the window that opens up titled "connect to a network", locate your EONI dialup connection and right click on that connection, then select "properties".



You should now be in your dialup properties window on the General tab; just add the appropriate area code in front of the rest of the number as illustrated below:



Click "OK" at the bottom of the screen and you are done!
